Dog and Cat shots will be at the City Shop on Saturday **April 18 from 9:00 AM - 11:00 AM**. All cats and dogs are required to have a city tag and have rabies shots.

Twice a week trash pick-up will begin in May. Pick up dates are Tuesday and Friday.

Hazardous Waste collection will be **June 13** from 9:00 am to 12:00 noon at the old fire station on Main Street.

Spring Clean-up is **June 1 through June 7** at the city dump (details regarding acceptable items and times will be available at City Hall or C & V).

**No Parking in Alleys.** Trash is not allowed in the alleys. Please be sure your alley is clear of debris.

Please clean up after shooting at the dump site. If trash is not picked up shooting will not be allowed in the future.

City Council meets the first and third Monday of every month at 6:30 p.m. at the new City Building. The public is welcome to attend any meeting. City office hours are 8:30 a.m. to noon and 1:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m.

The city dump is licensed for tree limbs and grass only. We are getting a lot of plastic flower pots, plastic bottles, plastic bags and lumber. Failure to comply with this policy could result in the closing of the dump by the State. When the State officials do a random inspection, they will shut us down if these items are found. We appreciate your cooperation.
